Taste Testing for Food and Drinks COVIDSafe Compliance Checklis	t
Do you <b>ensure</b> :	
<ul> <li>workers and customers wear face masks in line with <u>current</u> requirements unless they have a lawful reason not to. Face masks can be removed when eating or drinking.</li> </ul>	
everyone adheres to density quotients of two people per one square metre	
<ul> <li>cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces after each group of patrons and immediately after a spill.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>regular cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces, including implements used for food display or serving</li> </ul>	
Do you, in accordance with the Victorian Governments' recommendations:	
<ul> <li>encourage good hand hygiene where fresh or sample produce is available, and ensure hand sanitiser is available for patrons upon entry and exit, as well as during sampling activities</li> </ul>	
do not allow sharing of food and provide individual samples	

have one person distributing sample food or drinks		
<ul> <li>encourage physical distancing (for example by using floor markers), and discourage crowding around food and drink samples</li> </ul>		
discourage touching of fresh produce		
ask customers to place a bag over their hand when selecting and packing loose produce		
have one or more COVID Marshal(s) present to ensure COVIDSafe compliance		
provide single-use items, such as crockery, where possible		
<ul> <li>provide waste disposal options for single-use items, such as crockery and left-over samples</li> </ul>		
consider using Perspex shields for food display and while serving		
<ul> <li>keeping records of customer details, where practical, with electronic record keeping preferred. The Victorian Government QR Code Service is free and easy to use.</li> </ul>
